Dear Deputy Jones:

After our telephone conference on Wednesday, July 2, 2003, I have decided to Dismiss you in accordance with P.R. 1800-2 ART.1. Miscellaneous and Fulton County Sheriff's Department Work Rule Violation – 2.25 Unsatisfactory Performance

Your dismissal is effective at the end of shift Friday, July 4, 2003.

**TO WIT:**

You were negligent in that you failed to assure that Inmate Akbar Mubarik was cleared to be released on bond prior to releasing him to A Rapid Bonding Company. The facts in this case indicate that a hold for Dekalb County was clearly marked on the #1 card. The hold indicated for Dekalb County should have prompted you the releasing deputy to contact the above county for pick-up. Your actions allowed inmate Mubarik to be released in error.

If you feel that the above decision to dismiss you is based on personal, political or religious reasons or that it is not otherwise justified, PR-900-1 gives you the right to appeal to the Fulton County Personnel Board by answering the charges in writing and requesting a hearing. Any such request would have to be received by the Fulton County Personnel Board within ten (10) working days after being notified of my decision. An appeal form is enclosed for you.
